PROCEDURES TO OPEN CAMP- JULY 24

When arriving please go to Registration First!

WHERE: Elkhorn Registration Building (top of hill) a table will be set up in the lot near dorms

- Band payments and forms must be turned in prior to camp.
- Please meet with nurse to discuss any special medical needs/turn in medication in a Ziploc bag labeled with student's name.
- All students must check in and receive a ticket prior to unloading luggage into dorm.

*All Fees MUST be paid prior to camp. Students with unpaid fees will NOT perform with the Big Red Band until fees are paid or reasonable arrangements are made.

PROCEDURE FOR CLOSING CAMP:

Camp clean up: All band members will participate in a general clean up of the camp facilities.

Dismissal: Students will be dismissed from Elkhorn July 28 at 7:30PM. Students may be picked up between 7:30 and 8:00PM. Please do not come before this time. Students WILL NOT be released until the dorm parents, Mrs. Thacker & Mr. Hicks are satisfied with the cleanliness of the dorms. Cars will not be permitted up the drive way until 7:30PM. Please be prompt when picking up your child.

Please be patient. This is a new procedure and timing may not be entirely accurate. We will do our very best to be ready for 7:30 pick up. Please remain at your car until you are signaled to approach the dorms.

ALL STUDENTS ARE TO REPORT TO HMS FRIDAY JULY 29 AT 9:00AM. Any student not at rehearsal July 29 may be removed from the Big Red Band. Friday is still a day at camp, and camp is required of all students. Students will not be excused Friday for appointments. Please reschedule.

Departure: Loading of luggage should not start until the dorm has been excused and after cleaning. Please park in the area marked for visiting cars. **NO CARS SHOULD DRIVE INTO THE DORM AREA.**

Performance: There will be a performance by the Big Red Band at 7:00PM Friday July 29 at HMS. We will be using proceeds from the performance to add to our trip fund for Disney so Invite ALL OF YOUR FRIENDS AND FAMILY!!!

PLEASE NOTE: Violation of camp policy, including arrival procedure, visitation policy, and departure procedure will be cause for disciplinary action to be taken upon the respective student. This includes violation from non-family member, boyfriends, girlfriends and family members.

Camp Regulations and Elkhorn Rules:

There are a limited number of electrical outlets in each room. Decide with your class who will bring what. (multi plugs)

Nothing may be mounted on the walls

NO REFRIGERATORS are permitted in the dorms.

Shoes must be worn at all times

Speed limit is 10 mile per hour

NO smoking or use of tobacco or Vape in any form.

Absolutely no swimming in the pool or lakes unless camp lifeguard is present

No boating unless the lifeguard is present

Swimwear- NO cut-offs or 2 piece bathing suits. NO French cut or boy's competition suits

No sleepwear outside of dorm rooms
No Profanity while at camp

Big Red Band Rules:

Students must eat at all scheduled meals.

Refrain from soda drinks during off time. Hydrate with water/ Gatorade during camp.

Students are NOT permitted to leave camp for any non-emergency reasons.

Stereos/speakers MUST be operated at a decent level. (If asked to turn it after down after a warning, your system will be taken OUT of the dorm and returned to you on closing day.)

Make sure area around dorms is clean and neat at all times during camp.

Plan for extended rehearsals with heat. BE PREPARED.

Students are not allowed tank tops or t-shirts with cut-off sleeves on the field during camp.

Shoulders MUST be covered at all times.

Students do NOT have free reign of the premises. Boundaries will be established and clearly explained to students. Any student found to be outside of the boundaries will be given one warning, and will be sent home after the second infraction.

Daily camp schedule is approximate and may change as deemed necessary by the Director.

Cell Phone Policy: We are at camp TO LEARN, REHEARSE, AND PREPARE FOR MARCHING BAND SEASON. We are putting a large amount of time and money into this experience. While at camp it is expected that this is our primary focus.

Cell service at Elkhorn is mostly non-existent.

Students are permitted to have cell phones and are expected to use them for tuners, metronomes, alarms, and time keeping.

- Excessive use during rehearsal times will result in confiscation.
- Students are made aware of the appropriate boundaries at camp. If a signal is found within the boundaries of camp the student may use their phone for texting/calls during breaks only.
- If any student goes beyond these boundaries looking for a cell signal, their phone will be confiscated for the remainder of camp. Likewise, if a student is on a device for personal use during rehearsal the device will also be confiscated.

If a phone is confiscated, parents will be notified and the device will be kept in the director's cabin turned off until Saturday at the conclusion of camp.

Dormitory Behavior: Above all, use good judgment and respect the rights of others. The following rules must be observed:

- Loud noises, general "rowdiness" will not be tolerated.
- No boys in the girls' dorm and no girls in the boys' dorm for any reason. You WILL be sent home!!!
- Rooms are to be kept in neat condition at all times; carefully store foods to prevent insects.

- No noise is to be heard outside your dorm after lights out. All students must rest each night in order to remain healthy and contribute to their fullest potential throughout the duration of the camp.
- Dorms are to left in satisfactory condition; any vandalism is cause for dismissal from camp

Immediate Expulsion from Band Camp:

Excessive Profanity, Insubordination, Disrespect
 Being in the dorm of the opposite sex
 Horseplay in the dorms- shaving cream, water balloons, water guns, etc.
 Defacing of property of any kind.
 Theft of another band member’s property.
 Disrespect to Elkhorn camp staff, SHS camp staff, director’s, or chaperones.
 Leaving Elkhorn camp (going beyond boundaries) without permission.
 Any other unreasonable or inappropriate actions as deemed by Director.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Students who do not attend the entire duration of camp will not participate in band until after football season and may be subject to dismissal from the band program.
- Students sent home from camp for disciplinary reasons will not participate in band until after football season and may be subject to dismissal from band entirely.

Students must follow the rules and regulations of Steubenville High School while participating in camp. If any rules are violated, parents will be asked to come and pick up their child and a phone call will be made to the principal and disciplinary action will be taken at the beginning of school. If disciplinary action needs to be made while at camp, a meeting with Principal, Parent, Director and Student may take place upon return to Steubenville. Students who are not in good financial standing with SHS Big Red Band will not perform until fees are paid in full, or reasonable arrangements are made.
